The Tribunal has been requested under section 9(1)(b) of its Act to assist the Minister for Transport Services in the setting of fares for taxi services.

To assist stakeholders in making their submissions, the Tribunal has released an issues paper on the review. The Tribunal invites submissions from stakeholders and interested parties. To allow consideration of the pricing proposals and information submitted, submissions from the Taxi Council and the Transport Workers' Union will be required by 19 March 2004. Submissions from other stakeholders are required by 8 April 2004.

Once registered by the Tribunal, and unless confidentiality is sought, copies of all public submissions will be available from the Tribunal's office or from its website (www.ipart.nsw.gov.au).

The Tribunal will make its fare recommendation to the Minister for Transport Services in June 2004 in time for implementation by 1 July 2004.
