The public hearing will be conducted as a roundtable discussion of key issues. Roundtable participants will include IPART, Hunter Water and other key stakeholders.

## **Format of proceedings**

The day will be split into two sessions. The morning session will focus on Hunter Water's proposed prices and the afternoon session will cover other issues, such as its proposed expenditure. For each session, IPART will give a brief introduction. The Chair will then invite participants sitting at the roundtable to respond to IPART's introductory comments and questions and/or comments made by other roundtable participants. Once the roundtable participants have put forward and discussed their positions, the Chair will then invite members of the audience to make statements or ask questions.
