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Review of AGLGN Capital and Operating Expenditure

Section 2.28A of the National Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipelines permits a Regulator to agree to the proposed revisions to an Access Arrangement and Access Arrangement Information that have the effect of applying the revised Access Arrangement to one or more other covered pipelines that have the same Regulator and Service Provider as the covered pipeline to which the proposed revisions and Access Arrangement Information relate. The AGL New South Wales Distribution system, the AGL Central West Distribution system, the Wilton to Newcastle transmission pipeline and the Wilton to Wollongong transmission pipeline have the same Regulator and the same Service Provider.

AGLGN requests that in the review of the AGLGN Access Arrangement, IPART to treat the following four pipelines as a single covered Pipeline, as allowed under section 2.28A of the Code:

- the AGL New South Wales Distribution system;
- the AGL Central West Distribution system;
- the Wilton to Newcastle transmission pipeline;
- the Wilton to Wollongong transmission pipeline.
