Scott, Ruth,

The AGLGN proposal to delay the draft review submission date and consequent commencement date for the next Access Arrangement by 6 months is seen by this customer as acceptable, subject to the expected consequences presented at our meeting with AGLGN.

In brief, it is desirable to avoid double attention/ effort/ costs to an AA Review with a Gas Code Review (as per Parer) occurring this year.

It is also understood that a delay agreed by IPART will leave terms and conditions unchanged for all parties until new AA in place, and that in particular, Reference Tariffs ([REDACTED]), as at June 30th 2004 will be "frozen", with no CPI adjust imposed, until new Arrangements are decided.
