# Retail price disclosure guideline

For retail suppliers of small retail customers

Electricity and Gas  
Draft Guideline  
May 2010

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# 1 Background

## 1.1 Guideline authority

This Guideline is issued by the Minister for Energy under section 181A(2) of the *Electricity Supply Act 1995* and section 75AA(2) of the *Gas Supply Act 1996* and applies to **retail suppliers**. It is a condition of a **retail supplier's** licence that it must provide **pricing information** in accordance with this Guideline.

## 1.2 Purpose of this Guideline

The purpose of this Guideline is to specify the **pricing information** that a **retail supplier** is required to publish, provide in writing to any person on request, and provide to **IPART** to improve price transparency for customers and to enable the establishment and ongoing operation of a price comparison service. These measures will allow **small retail customers** to access current **pricing information** and more effectively participate in the NSW contestable retail energy market.

The online price comparison service is administered by **IPART** with a complementary telephone service administered by NSW Fair Trading. This will ensure that **small retail customers** with limited internet access are also able to benefit from the price comparison service.

A **small retail customer** should be able to identify any **energy offers** applicable to their circumstances. **Small retail customers** should be able to access this information from the **retail supplier** directly or via the online price comparison service.

Most energy suppliers operating in NSW also operate in other jurisdictions with existing price disclosure requirements, and that there is a national process underway to develop price disclosure requirements on energy suppliers under the National Energy Customer Framework. This Guideline endeavours to achieve consistency with existing requirements and take into account national developments in order to reduce the regulatory burden on energy suppliers, where these consistencies are considered to produce the most beneficial outcomes for **small retail customers** in NSW.

This Guideline specifies the minimum requirements in relation to:

- a) the publication of **pricing information** on a **retail supplier's** internet site;
- b) the provision of **pricing information** by a **retail supplier** to any person on request; and
- c) the provision of **pricing information** by a **retail supplier** to **IPART** to facilitate an online price comparison service.

### 1.3 Commencement date

This Guideline commences on X XXXX 2010.

### 1.4 Amendment or replacement

The Minister for Energy may amend or replace this Guideline or any part thereof at any time.

## 2 When and how pricing information must be provided

### 2.1 Access to pricing information on a retailer supplier's internet site

A *retail supplier* must publish on its internet site the *pricing information* for all of that *retail supplier's* available *energy offers*. The *pricing information* for an energy offer must be published:

- (a) in a single document available on the *retail supplier's* internet site; or
- (b) on a single page on the *retail supplier's* internet site.

The home page of a *retail supplier's* internet site must have a link that allows a person to access the *retail supplier's pricing information* easily, logically and free of charge.

### 2.2 Disclosure of pricing information to any person on request

A *retail supplier* must disclose *pricing information* for all available *energy offers* to any person on request. This disclosure must be in writing and be sent by the *retail supplier* within 3 days of the request being made.

When providing a person with written *pricing information*, a *retail supplier* must comply with clause 3.2 of this Guideline.

### 2.3 Disclosure of pricing information to IPART

#### 2.3.1 Disclosure of pricing information

A *retail supplier* must provide *IPART* with the *pricing information* for all available *energy offers* within 48 hours of the commencement date of this Guideline specified in clause 1.3.

A *retail supplier* must provide *IPART* with the *pricing information* by completing the electronic spreadsheet provided by *IPART*, a copy of which is set out in Schedule A, for each *energy offer*.

### 2.3.2 Changes to pricing information

A *retail supplier* must provide *IPART* with information regarding prospective changes to the *pricing information*, including the introduction of new *energy offers* and the withdrawal of *energy offers*:

- (a) by completing the electronic spreadsheet provided by *IPART*, a copy of which is set out in Schedule A; and
- (b) at least 48 hours prior to such changes becoming effective.

### 2.3.3 Provision of links to retail supplier's internet site

A *retail supplier* must provide to *IPART* a link to the *retail supplier's* internet site where information regarding *energy offers* is contained free of charge.

A *retail supplier* must notify *IPART* if any links to the *retail supplier's* internet site change.

### 2.3.4 Statement accompanying information

Any information provided to *IPART* under clauses 2.3.1 and 2.3.2 must be accompanied by a statement signed by the chief executive officer of the *retail supplier* or the chief executive officer's duly authorised delegate, verifying that the information is correct and up to date.

## 3 What is pricing information and when must it be provided

### 3.1 What is pricing information

The following information is *pricing information* for the purposes of section 181A(5) of the *Electricity Supply Act 1995* and section 75AA(5) of the *Gas Supply Act 1996*:

- (a) The name of the *energy offer*, the class of customers, the meter type, and the location to which it applies and any other eligibility criteria;

- (b) All fees (inclusive of GST) and charges (exclusive of GST and before any discounts are applied) separately disclosed including the supply charge, consumption tariffs and early termination fees where applicable (consumption tariffs must be disclosed on a cents per kWh or cents per MJ basis and supply charges must be disclosed on a cents per day basis);
- (c) A description of the circumstances in which a fee or charge is payable by a *small retail customer*;
- (d) Any non tariff charges (inclusive of GST) charged by the *retail supplier* for a service provided by a *distribution network service provider*;
- (e) An explanation of how the *retail supplier* intends to make any changes to any tariffs, fees and charges;
- (f) An explanation of any discounts, and the tariff components to which they apply;
- (g) A description of any other price incentives (for example, upfront rebates, certain time period free);
- (h) A description of any non price incentives;
- (i) The length of the contract and an explanation of the circumstances in which a termination fee will be levied;
- (j) A description of any *green product* including its price (exclusive of GST);
- (k) Where the *retail supplier* intends to make the offer or any part of the *energy offer* available only for a fixed period, the last date on which the *energy offer* will be available;
- (l) A description of the process by which further information on terms and conditions of the *energy offer* can be obtained from the *retail supplier*;
- (m) For consumption block tariffs: the consumption threshold(s) and, if applicable, the time periods for which they apply;
- (n) For time of use tariffs: when each time period applies and the price for each time period;
- (o) A description of any *feed-in tariff credits or payments* available; and
- (p) For all *energy offers* to residential *small retail customers* who do not have a time of use meter: a calculation of an annual bill (inclusive of GST and any discounts) for each *consumption level*.

### 3.2 Pricing information to be provided without additional information being requested

A *retail supplier* must make the *pricing information* available to any person without requesting that that person provide information that is not necessary to determining available *energy offers*.

Information that is not necessary to determining available *energy offers* includes:

- ▼ Technical information such as a person's current retail tariff, distribution network tariff and national metering identifier or meter installation registration number; and
- ▼ Personal information such as a person's name, date of birth or driver's licence number.

If a *retail supplier* requires a person's meter type in order to determine available offers, the person must be provided with clear and non-technical explanations sufficient to enable them to identify their meter type easily.

## 4 Definitions and Interpretation

### 4.1 Definitions

In this Guideline:

*Consumption level* means the following:

- (a) for *small retail customers* of electricity:
  - (i) 3 MWh per year (consumed over 12 months);
  - (ii) 7 MWh per year (consumed over 12 months);
  - (iii) 11 MWh per years (consumed over 12 months); and
  - (iv) 1.5 MWh of *controlled load* (consumed over 12 months); and
- (b) for *small retail customers* of natural gas:
  - (i) 6 GJ per year (consumed over 12 months);
  - (ii) 24 GJ per year (consumed over 12 months); and
  - (iii) 45 GJ per year (consumed over 12 months).

*Controlled load* means an electricity load which is active only at certain times, where such times are determined and controlled by the *distribution network service provider*.

*Distribution network service provider* means a distribution network service provider as defined in the *Electricity Supply Act 1995* or a distributor as defined in the *Gas Supply Act 1996*.



**Energy offer** means an offer by a **retail supplier** to supply electricity or natural gas to **small retail customers** which is available to most **small retail customers** who:

- (a) are in the location where the offer is available;
- (b) have the same type of meter;
- (c) are in the same customer class; and
- (d) may or may not receive **feed-in tariff credits or payments**;

whether or not that offer is:

- (d) an offer by a **retail supplier** to supply both electricity and gas to a **small retail customer** (a dual fuel offer);
- (e) an offer provided under a standard form customer supply contract as defined in the *Gas Supply Act 1996* or a standard form customer connection contract as defined in the *Electricity Supply Act 1995* (standard form customer contract); or
- (f) a **green product**.

**Note:** For example, an **energy offer** would not include the following:

- ▼ an offer that requires a **small retail customer** to also have a particular gym membership or be a member of a particular association;
- ▼ an offer that is only available to a **small retail customer** who attends or is employed at a particular institution;

**Feed-in tariff credit or payment** means a credit or payment to a **small retail customer** for electricity generated by that **small retail customer's** renewable energy generator.

**Green product** means a product for which a **small retail customer** pays an amount to voluntarily contribute towards a green energy outcome.

**IPART** means the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal of New South Wales established under the *Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal Act 1992* (NSW).

**Pricing information** means the information specified in clause 2.2 of this Guideline.

**Retail supplier** means a supplier as defined in the *Gas Supply Act 1996* or a retail supplier as defined in the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*.

**Small retail customer** has the meaning given to that term in section 33R of the *Gas Supply Act 1996* or section 92 of the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*.

## 4.2 Interpretation

In this Guideline:

- (a) headings are for convenience only and do not affect the interpretation of this Guideline;
- (b) a reference to a clause or a schedule is a reference to a clause or schedule in this Guideline;
- (c) words importing the singular include the plural and vice versa;
- (d) a reference to a law or statute includes all amendments or replacements of that law or statute;
- (e) a reference to a person includes a company, partnership, joint venture, association, corporation, other body corporate or government agency;
- (f) a reference to an officer includes a reference to the officer who replaces him or her, or who substantially succeeds to his or her powers or functions;
- (g) a reference to a body, whether statutory or not:
  - (i) which ceases to exist; or
  - (ii) whose powers or functions are transferred to another body,is a reference to the body which replaces it or which substantially succeeds to its powers or functions; and
- (h) explanatory notes do not form part of this Guideline, but in the case of uncertainty may be relied on for interpretation purposes.

## Schedule A Prescribed format

Every retail offer must be completed on a new sheet.

For dual fuel offers please complete sections for both electricity AND gas, otherwise just complete for the relevant fuel.

All descriptive fields will be displayed on the website in the words used by the retailer.
