Flow Systems Operations Pty Ltd and Flow Systems Pty Ltd applications for WIC Act licence variations at Box Hill North

WHAT

We have received applications for variations to the licences that authorise the provision of sewerage and recycled water services to residential and commercial customers at **Box Hill North**.

The variation applications seek to:

- Expand the area of operations to supply recycled water to approximately 38 additional customers with an aggregate of 330 hectares of land.
- Add end uses for recycled water for car washing, general wash down on hard surfaces, street cleaning and process water at the recycled water treatment plant.



WHERE

The Box Hill North scheme is located within The Hills Shire Council local government area. The proposed extended recycled water area of operations is identified on the map.



WHO

Flow Systems Operations Pty Ltd is the holder of the Box Hill North network operator's licence (number 16_037) and is authorised to construct, maintain and operate water industry infrastructure. Flow Systems Pty Ltd (parent company of Flow Systems Operations) is the holder of the retail supplier's licence (number 13_001R) and provides retail services at Box Hill North.

HOW

The licences were granted under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006* (NSW) (the WIC Act).

The network operator's licence variation application is to include additional end uses for recycled water for the whole scheme.

Flow Systems Operations Pty Ltd proposes to connect the new customers to recycled water infrastructure that has been or can be constructed under their current network operator's licence. It considers that new customer connection points will be at the boundaries of the customer's properties. Any infrastructure extension within the customer's properties will therefore be downstream of the connection point, and does not need to be covered by the licence.

The retail supplier's licence variation application is for:

Extending the area of operations to supply recycled water to include approximately 38 additional customers. Sewerage services are not proposed to be extended.



Including additional end uses for recycled water for the whole scheme.



WHEN

The submissions period is now open and will close on 21 November 2019.



WHY

The licence variations, if granted, would authorise the licensees and any nominated authorised persons to construct, maintain and operate water industry infrastructure and to supply retail services in the area specified. These activities cannot be undertaken without a licence.
