

Further to my previous submission I would like to just add one more point after just having seen the movie Inconvenient Truth. One of the messages of this movie is that we humans need to reduce CO2 emissions in order to combat global warming. Reducing reliance on cars and encouraging people to use mass transport such as buses, ferries, trains is a key initiative.

Public transport fares need to be set at a level which will encourage maximum patronage. Raising fares and making journeys excessively expensive (eg the return ferry fare from Cremorne Point to Circular Quay is \$10 plus the connecting bus has to be paid in addition to this) does not help in discouraging people from using cars.

I hope you will consider these comments accordingly.
