

CHANGE OF RELEASE DATE – NSW COUNCIL SPECIAL RATE VARIATIONS AND MINIMUM RATES FOR 2012/13

IPART will be releasing its decisions on 15 applications from NSW councils seeking special rate variations or minimum rate increases on Monday 4 June at 10am.

This is earlier than previously advised (was 6 June).

The decisions relate to:

- 13 applications from councils to increase their general income
- 2 applications from councils to increase their minimum rates above statutory limits.
