Re: Consultation on draft ToR for review of NSW distribution reliability standards

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft terms of reference (ToR) for IPART's upcoming review of the NSW electricity distribution reliability standards. Reliability standards directly impact upon required levels of capital and operating expenditure and therefore overall network charges, so it is important that are carefully considered.
