Essential Energy welcomes the opportunity to comment on the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) issues paper for the Review of the financeability test.

Essential Energy supports IPART assessing financeability as part of its regulatory decisions. There is value for all stakeholders in ensuring businesses remain capable of obtain debt financing following a regulatory decision.

We see no need for IPART to alter its current approach and analysis to assessing financeability, other than updating the Moody's ratio bandings to provide clearer distinctions. We see no additional value to stakeholders from extending the analysis and certainly do not support the financeability test becoming akin to a credit rating assessment.
