Unfortunately it is in the interest of the companies to delay as long as possible even this miserable amount. The feed-in tariff should represent the true value of solar, this means recognising the environmental benefits and the network benefits of rooftop solar. I have written to red Energy on a number of occasions asking when I will be supplied with the smart meter, but have not got a satisfactory answer. I suspect they will delay even this as long as possible. This needs to be regulated by the NSW Government in order to be fair to consumers.
