I believe it is time the the solar feed-in tariff benchmark be increased to keep in line with the increasing cost of wholesale electricity.

The NSW solar feed-in tariff has not kept pace with electricity increases and should be increased to encourage the expansion of rooftop solar installations. More rooftop solar installations will supplement the grid during times of high demand in summer and further reduce our greenhouse gas emissions.

My present feed-in tariff of 6.1 cents per kWh is approximately 20% of what I pay my retailer for a kWh of electricity during PEAK hours. A reasonable increase in the tariff will provide the incentive to increase the capacity of my existing installation.
