as part of the IPART tribunal I wish to highlight the inappropriate price paid for Solar generated Power. I believe there should be a mandatory price set on Solar generated power to stop the unfair and bordering on collusion by large power supply companies. Paying 6 cents per Kwh and selling this same power to nearby customers some maybe next door for a price of 400% increase of say 24c per Kwh I urge the tribunal to act fairly to all concerned and have the price of Solar generated power to a minimum price of 12c to 15 cents but also acknowledging that Solar generated Power is actually valued considerably higher than 15cents when we consider the carbon neutral values and the relative short distance between producer and consumer resulting in considerable reduced 'wasted' power lost over distance and time in the traditional Coal fired generation and extensive distances this power travels to some far-off consumers. Trusting the Tribunal will recognise and reward the Solar generated Power suppliers and the positive environmental value this form of power can offer.
