Submission: This is nothing more than a new tax. In many cases the increase in price has been more than 10 cents (often 15 cents) per container. Who gets the difference? My view is that all containers suitable for this scheme were already being collected in our yellow bins and were being recycled by the contractors. This yellow bin service is being paid for through our rates. Many people including myself find the process of saving these containers separate to the yellow bin is an unnecessary bother combined with the time and expense of taking these containers to the refund point make it uneconomic. I strongly object to the fact that I am now paying twice to have these containers disposed of. Until this process becomes more user friendly or economically viable I intend to protest by placing these eligible containers in the red bin and therefore into land fill.
