We have purchased a \$30k excavator to do all our storm water works on our farms. We have dams capture the storm water. It is great asset to us. It is stored for irrigation to grow fresh produce for the local market.

Local people ask us. Does the government help us farmers. This is not help this is revenue for the council to squeeze us out of this area.

If you have storm water infrastructure in this area please indicate where your storm water works are so we can know what your charging us extra for.

This \$5427.81 on top of our rates is a disgrace. As well a disgrace on how much notice for this large increase in rates. This is un-Australian. Every one deserves a fair amount of notice and a fair go.
