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Submission: I object to this proposal. The original approvals avoided release of effluent (whether treated or not) outside of the development boundary. Now the cheapest option is being applied for because certain factors have not worked out for the developers. The cheapest option would result in the release of treated effluent on an ongoing basis into the lagoon on the beach that my family, kids and the local community swim in and ingest! I cannot support such an approval variation. The developers should need to implement outcomes that are consistent with the original approvals, even if additional costs are incurred. Such outcomes should include connection to the local sewer network or trucking of excess effluent to an external treatment facility. The ecology of the waterways and the community's health is at stake.
