Submission: I am an adult aged under 60yrs, I am not entitled to any concession cards & my income is fixed. I recently moved into Coffs Harbour township and my intention was to use the local bus network more frequently. However, the cost of a ticket from my closest bus stop into Coffs Harbour town centre is \$5.
