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Submission: I am a level two electrician, I have had my accreditation & authorisation for some twenty years & have spent many thousands of dollars in keeping it during all the changes over these years. I worked in a metering section of the local council some ten years before that & realise the importance of getting metering right. I was astounded with the recent change to asps resulted in meter installations being given to metering companies who did not have (to my knowledge) any trained meter installers but invited asps to become accredited with them after a short training session. I did not go down this path but do know a couple of local asps who spent a considerably amount of time & money to become their installers. My recent experiences of having metering installed is as follows, I customer called their energy provider meter was installed in three weeks free of charge 2. Told customer to ring their energy provider (the company they obtained their NMI from) they were told the metering will be done within the next three Monday's and were told the metering company would be in contact with me to see what was required, that was roughly the start of May 2018. 3 a builder i do work for but not my job has been waiting 8 weeks for power to turned on. WHY CHANGE A SYSTEM THAS WAS WORKING FINE
