I have read that IPART is going to make solar feedin tariffs 12c per Kwh. This is a good start but I think it is still a bit low. IPART should make the solar feed in rate mandatory and not have a range.

I believe that IPART should make feedin tariffs a set figure of at a minimum 50% of the rate paid by consumers. Remember that the daily connection fee covers the retailers and generators fixed costs including distribution. Obviously the solar feedin rate will rise as does any rise in the retail or wholesale rate of electricity.

I as a consumer have 2 properties and between them over the last 3 months have put into the grid more power than I have used.

When IPART regulates the solar feedin tariff I remind IPART of what it says on the web site IPART provides independent regulatory decisions and advice to protect the ongoing interests of the consumers, taxpayers and citizens of NSW and is not empowered to maximise profits of private companies

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
