Submission: "I am most concerned that IPART is considering reducing the feed-in tariff to 8-9c /kWh. It is unfair to penalise solar power producers for having reduced the demand for power produced by the coal-fired power stations. IPART must ensure that retailers pay a fair f.i.t. and that solar producers are treated fairly.
