Some points for IPART to consider: That IPART should support a fair price for solar.

The feed-in tariff is a miserable 6c/kWh and should increase in line with the wholesale price of electricity otherwise it is as miniscule and miserable as the 4c petrol dockets. Worth 5% when fuel was 80 cents but less than 3% now it's \$1.50.

The feed-in tariff should not just be a benchmark range, it should be regulated so retailers have to offer it as a minimum.
