I support a fair price for the NSW solar feed-in tariff. It should increase in line with the wholesale price of electricity.

The feed-in tariff should not just be a benchmark range, it should be regulated so retailers have to offer it as a minimum.

The feed-in tariff should represent the true value of owners of solar PV systems, this means recognising the environmental and health benefits as well as the network benefits of rooftop solar.

I am currently receiving an 8.2c kWh FiT. However, I'm paying an average 40c kWh (including the daily supply charge) when I have to import electricity. Frankly, this is quite outrageous. A minimum FiT of around 15c kWh would be far more equitable considering the savings my investment is creating for electricity generation and supply companies.
