Hi,

I have a 5.2kw solar system installed for almost 2 years.

The minimum energy generation from our solar system has been 7 times our electrical consumption, yet I still don't earn enough from the payment for my electrical generation to cover my electrical bills!!

Solar is a clean energy and delivers far greater environmental benefits than alternatives, yet I am paid \$0.06 per solar Kw we produce and are charged a minimum of \$0.27 per Kw used. A minimum of \$0.21 profit on the solar Kw we produce.

The commercial rate for wholesale electricity fluctuates but is much higher than the super cheap fee paid to me and others like me who supply power to the grid. It's time to make the fee for our solar contribution to society (its the same electricity as produced by coal only a lot cleaner) fair and equitable and indexed to the wholesale market fee and should be regulated.
