Re: Catherine Hill Bay application by Solo Water to vary effluent treatment

I wish to make the strongest objections to Solo Water's application to vary the handling of effluent from the Catherine Hill Bay development site to permit its discharge into public water.

It seems strongly suggestive of deceptive conduct on the part of Solo Water to obtain permission for a controversial development which was the subject of much public protest with the claim effluent would be handled on site and not adversely affect the public or the environment. Now it wants to repudiate these plans and assurances and expose the public to significant public health risk and the environment to regular and harmful pollution. This is a real loss to the amenity of life the local community and wider public currently enjoys.

It would seem also seem to expose parties to such a change to charges of criminal negligence, if permission was granted to permit the discharge of effluent into a public space with such potential risks. .

We would therefore, ask as a matter of real importance to the life of Catherine Hill Bay and its many visitors that this quite disgusting and "underhand" application to pollute and endanger our public waterways and beach be completely rejected.
