The sewage company was given approval to treat its sewage on site for that development. Our houses have a pump out system and we have been able to contain all our sewage without it being pumped into the mangrove area. At the back of our house, where the development now want to discharge their sewage, is the creek which at the moment is not flowing. My understanding is that this creek is where the sewage would be discharged from the development and the sewage would stagnate. When the rain comes this would then run under the bridge and onto the surf area. The water that collects at the bridge is where the children play and it is washed out only at times of heavy rainfall. My feeling is that we are dealing with a company that is not ethical, ruining the environment to save money, all waste water should be dealt with on the site and excess pumped to Belmont sewage works .Why should the original approval be changed? Why should sewage from a new development be pumped over to the original village?
