We currently receive 6c per kilowatt. When we first connected we received 8c per kilowatt even though other people who had connected shortly before us received 60c per kilowatt.

My wife and I would like to receive a more substantial benefit for our solar than the miserable and penny pinching effort that we receive at the moment.

On the basis that solar electricity production is between 9 am - 4pm daily (except overcast/rain days) Energy Australia sells my solar input for .1933c per kilowatts during the shoulder period (bet 10am - 2pm) & during peak consumption (bet 2pm-4pm) they sell it for .4826c per kilowatt.

So they are making a killing after we outplayed the cost for the panels.

I don't like being ripped off or taken as a 'patsy' by any body.
