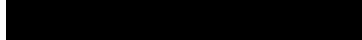


SUBMISSION TO IPART REVIEW

I support the proposed increase in the NSW solar feed-in tariff benchmark to 11.6-14.6c per kWh and further increases linked to an increase in the wholesale price of electricity. Solar is exported when prices are at their peak so retailers are price gouging in an obscene way. I am receiving 12c/kWh from a small start up community owned retailer so the big companies must be able to avoid this easily. 12c/kWh should be the legislated minimum and the tariff indexed to the wholesale price.
