I am sure you are aware of all this but for me to utilize my full generator electricity I would have to spend another multiple thousands of dollars in a storage system.

I do not feel that Australia is promoting solar generation to its full capacity given that our geological location is one of the best in the world.

Given that the retail market is so competitive I feel that the feed in tariff should be regulated as we have a product to sell but have not the sales teams to compete in this market.

Environmentally, I feel that the encouragement of further roof top installations move forward with true and definitive guide lines so that insurances can be used to have an inform decision that persons are contributing to lessen there carbon footprint.
