I support a fair price for solar. The specific example I can cite is my own case: I buy renewable Wind energy from my electricity provider when I need it at a price of around 39c per kWh (including the connection charge). When I export energy that is generated by our Solar PV during the day, I am paid only 8c per kWh. I understand that the network infrastructure poles and wires needs to be paid for, however this gap of 31c/kWh does seem inequitable.

Please work towards a regulated minimum payment for NSW residents' solar electricity.
