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Submission: I note the reduction in the on/off limits down to 60 an 70%. Whilst a step in the right direction, I would propose these limits should be a lot lower. 50% and 60% would be more reasonable. I understand the supply is approx 15% and that modelling may show a reduction in safety of supply. This should provide incentive to Sydney water to focus on the demand side, providing incentives to increase water efficiency (eg lower fixed cost, higher per unit cost) and to increase focus on losses in the system. This would be a far better outcome for the consumers of Sydney water. By having a monopoly, market forces are prevented from being at play as efficienctly as they should be. Please consider further lowering these triggers and encouraging a more efficient and market based system.
