As a producer of rooftop solar energy, I am bemused by the fact that I have not seen any rationale for IPART's NSW solar feed-in tariff benchmark.

In the 12 months from Jan 16 to Jan 17 my electricity usage charge (excl. daily supply charge and GST) was \$934.44. I used 4637kWhs in that period. That equates to a kWh cost to me of 20.15c/kWh.

So, when I sell to the grid I receive 7c/kWh, but when I have to buy it back off the grid I'm charged nearly 3 times what I sold it to the power companies for!

Where is the justice in IPART's current benchmark pricing?
