Please DO NOT cut the benchmark solar feed-in tariff (FiT) from 11c/kWh to 8-9c/kWh from 1 July.

The NSW Government must mandate a minimum FAIR price for solar.

'I invested in clean solar power for my home in 2016 because my electricity bills were spiralling and I wanted to reduce my impact on the grid.

- needs to be regulated and mandated so that the retailers have a duty to offer it as a minimum
