I am writing to you in support of a fair price for a NSW solar feed-in tariff, that represents the true price of solar power and encourages those who have moved to solar to remain on the grid and contribute to the energy network (rather than move off grid, causing increases in electricity costs for those that remain on the grid, due to the high cost of maintaining the network).
