## Dear IPART,

When the first Solar Feed-In Tariff was recommended at 6 cents cents per kilowatt I assumed that it was because the average Spot Price for major electricity generators was this price.

This ignored the fact that Solar Producers send their power into the wires during daytime, when the Spot Price is significantly higher. Hopefully the new recommended price is the daytime Average Spot Price.

But it also ignored the fact that Domestic Solar Producers do not use the longdistance Transmission Wires and Transformers, and this should justify a higher feed-in tariff for power that is produced, effectively, on-site. I hope you will consider this.
