Submission: It would be great if there were no odours coming from Waste Water Treatment Plant at North Head.

Odours are occurring now, so money must be spent to reduce these.

It is important that IPART's pricing decisions contribute to:

- The amount and quality of biosolids produced at North Head being improved;
- The treatments used reducing malodour generation and impacts on the community;
- Full assessment of the benefits of the process known as 'recuperative thickening' as part of optimising operations at the North Head WWTP;
- Water, stormwater and wastewater pricing being structured to encourage:
  - o sustainable practices (environmental, social and economic),
  - o a shift to 'Fit for Purpose' water use, and
  - o decentralisation of water treatment becoming the preferred approach to wastewater treatment.
