Submission: Due to recent bus changes, i'm now forced to take a combination of bus & train to get to work on a daily basis. Bus fare used to be 4.50 for the one way trip. However using both Bus & train I'm now forced to pay 6.88 - an increase of 2.38 per trip. This adds up to an additional \$20 PER WEEK, which i'm sure you would agree is unacceptable.
