Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed changes to Opal Fares.

Originally, the Opal Card was promoted with the incentive of free trips after 8 paid journeys.

<u>The proposed changes discriminate and harshly penalise passengers dependant on public transport during weekends.</u>

It is highly unfair that IPART proposes 10 paid journeys after the NSW government previously promised free trips after 8 paid journeys.

<u>The proposed changes will damage the environment through increased vehicle traffic congestion and result in decreased public transport usage.</u>

May I humbly offer a better solution:

- Opal Card passengers be charged for the 8 longest journeys on weekdays only (Mon Fri), instead of the 10 longest journeys for the whole week
- Passengers should not be charged for any journeys on weekends as long as they have paid for 8 journeys (Mon – Fri only)

I strongly oppose IPART's Draft Report in its current form and call for immediate changes.
