Submission: A couple of suggestions, although much of the proposal is to make the fare system fairer for all, however two important changes have it it UNfair for most:

1. Paid trips increased from 8 to 10 per week. It is unfair on every user who need to travel to work on a daily basis. It would to fairer to have charge the longest 8 trips each week rather than 10, especially after fares would be increased by the end of the proposed term from 7%-11%.

2. Gold card users and other concession card holders (arguably the most vulnerable and needy) will be slapped with a 60% increase by the end of the proposed period. For Gold card holders it is from the current \$2.50 max per day to \$4.00 max per day. This is a much higher increase than the average user fare increase. We have to question whether increase fares at such levels is reasonable on society's most vulnerable. It would be much fairer to keep the increase at average increase levels with other fares.
