Submission: I do not agree with many aspects of the proposed ticketing changes. I live in Erskineville and do not own a car. I rely on public transport for most of my transit needs, and take on average 10 trips per week. These changes would cause me to take public transport less and potentially replace public transport trips with car trips.

The aspects of the proposal that I most strongly disagree with are:

- Increasing the number of trips paid for per week from 8 trips to the 10 trips. This would increase the weekly cost of public transport by 25% which would make me consider taking my car to work and stop using public transport.
- Changing the weekly fare charge from the first 8 trips to the 10 most expensive trips during the week. This would be a discourage me from using public transport on weekend as it would become cheaper and more convenient to take a car.
