

We ask respectfully that you decline the submission for a Water Recycling & Sewage Treatment Plant license at 617 Freemans Drive. The proximity of this industrial style facility to residents in an existing quiet township is unacceptable. The property we purchased in 1992 is intended to be our forever home, not 100 or so metres from a facility of this kind. The proposed facility should not be placed at the heart of our town. In fact, at Pitt Town and other such developments facilities of this sort are placed on the outskirts of residential development. And even when placed there reduce the value of people's properties, after all in real estate, perception is everything.

I am still unconvinced that odor, noise, overflow issues and environmental concerns are going to be major issues in the future if this facility is built. Once built, if there are any issues it is too late.

If this is such a great facility, then please grant the licence for it to be built in the middle of the residential or even retail area of the Watagan Park development. Please keep it out of the heart of our town.
