Submission: As joint owner of a residence at [REDACTED], Cooranbong I am concerned about the proposal to build a sewerage/recycling plant at 617 Freemans Dve. The proposed location of the plant is adjacent to and opposite existing homes, community services (pre school, community centre) with a shopping village, church, nursing home and retirement villas nearby. I feel this is an established area and a project this size should be located away from suburbia. I am also worried about possible overflow and its effect on the pond opposite this site which is part of the Avondale Springs Estate. There is already a problem with sediment flowing into the pond during rain from the new housing estate which this proposed utility would service. Lake Macquarie Council is currently looking into this matter. This pond was previously a water haven for ducks and all forms of bird life but the numbers are rapidly dwindling, so more overflow possible from the proposed plant would be detrimental to this native environment.
