Submission: My family and I strongly object to the water treatment plant being proposed for Freesmans drive, Cooranabong.

This is a least the third letter I have written in protest at the location of this plant.

Our protest rests on a number of points:

- a/ seepage into waterways, creeks and floodwaters--as has happened this past week, and which happens in sporadic flash floods every tow years in Cooranabong
- b/ storms have cut power in Freemans drive for five days--how will this affect the plant and surrounding homes in the possibility that this should happen again
- c/ location within 800 metres--and in sight of food outlets, cafes and churches, childcare facilities and established homes,
- d/ the drop in value to our home which we cannot afford due to my contracting cancer and now being unable to work,
- e/ and the fact that my aspergers son has a high sensitivity to odour--which is one of the reasons we were happy choosing to purchase where we have--with there being no indication that an effluent treatment works would be nearby.

I would also like to state that there are many others who wish to make their submission but did not know, as I didn't, that we had the opportunity to submit again and cannot do so because of the current faulty internet situation.

If I wanted a cheap large block of land I would have bought in Marconi rd opposite the treatment works, but I didn't--I spent more to in a place with clean air. Please do not bring the treatment plant to our backyard, please connect the system to Marconi rd or Dora creek where management is more efficient, most sincerely Karen Muirhead
