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Submission: the main issue that needs to be addressed is for all sources of power fed into the grid should be at an equal rate. In other words it should make no difference if it is a coal fired power station, a wind farm, wave generator, large scale solar plant or a domestic solar system the cost recovered by the producer when feeding electricity into the grid should be equal. The current 6c rate received by domestic producers if equal to all other producers implies that the distribution and marketing sections of the electricity supply system are either very inefficient or making excessive profits. If the rate is not equal then I can determine no reason why one producer should receive any more than another. If equality exists then the down stream sectors of the supply system need to improve their game or reduce their profits. I recommend that any changes to the feed-in tariff reflect the above to achieve a more equitable system.
