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Submission: This does not concern you directly but action by Sydney Water is more probable if you refer it to them. It is possible that Sydney Water may be able to generate income by adopting the following - they are the best to cost it.

About 1km downstream of Warragamba Dam, there is a weir which was to be the original Dam site except the geology was unfavorable. By raising that weir by, say 10m, water could be delivered through the Dam's Power Station (little used) at Peak Electrical times (high Value). By pumping the water back into the Dam at Low flow and Off Peak Electrical, a nett profit will occur. There will be only minor water loss and the failure of the downstream weir will not cause significant flooding as relatively small quantities are stored.
