

I have recently installed solar panels at my home in Broken Hill and am appalled to find that any excess feed in to the system from my system is lost to me. I believe that if the Government fails to support any incentive to promote solar panel installation then at least a return credit from the electricity supplier to the same value as charged to the client should be a basic provision in law. That is, based on current charges at 24.904 to 26.228 Cents per kWh should be reimbursed for excess return feed in to the householder on the same provisions at which the charge is levied on the householder. After all, this is the price that will be charged to other clients receiving my excess feed?
