Subject: Compliance with IPART's Public Transport Fare Determinations

The Determinations by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) for Sydney Trains and NSW TrainLink Intercity services, Sydney Ferries and Sydney Metropolitan and Outer Metropolitan Buses require that Transport for NSW submit a pricing proposal to IPART when introducing new tickets or discontinuing existing tickets.

Opal is now operating on all Sydney Ferries, Sydney Trains and NSW TrainLink Intercity services, and is being progressively rolled out on buses across the greater Sydney metropolitan area. Over 440,000 Opal cards have been issued to customers to date. With the success of the Opal card roll out, 14 paper based tickets will be retired from 1 September 2014 to allow for the continued modernisation of the transport network and simplicity for customers.

Transport for NSW has reviewed public transport fares against IPART's existing Determinations taking into account both the retirement of some of the current paper based tickets and the implementation of Opal, and can confirm that fares continue to be below the maximums determined by IPART.
