

# STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

## Regulated retail prices and charges for gas, 2014/15

Based on IPART, *Changes in regulated retail gas prices from 1 July 2014 – Final Report, June 2014.*

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) has completed an assessment of the proposed regulated retail gas prices and charges for 2014/15. These are the prices the Standard Retailers in NSW – AGL, ActewAGL and Origin Energy – charge customers who have not signed a market contract with them or another retailer.

IPART has completed an assessment of each retailer's proposed prices and charges for 2014/15. Our assessment confirmed that:

- ▼ underlying network charges have been correctly passed through into retail prices
- ▼ the carbon and retail components have changed by no more than that approved by the Tribunal, and
- ▼ miscellaneous charges have changed by no more than agreed under the Voluntary Pricing Agreement.

IPART is satisfied that the proposed prices and charges for 2014/15 are in compliance with the Voluntary Pricing Agreements and the Tribunal's final decisions.
