Aren't we supposed to be encouraging people to use the Cityrail network, not discourage them?

It would be pure myopeia to raise fares at a time when every other price is rising, including oil prices.

Maybe encouraging the Government to fund the transport network a bit more can go a long way. The way the current government has treated it, one gets the impression that they don't even want to touch the Cityrail network. I can't see any benefits that will come from raising fares.

As an avid user of Cityrail, I will be disappointed and angry if fares continue to increase. There was also one hike a while ago, was there not? Is this an annual thing then?

People are angry at this proposal for a reason. It's because it only discourages more people from using the network.

Perhaps one should travel to other countries around the world, in Europe preferably, where governments actually are CAPABLE at effectively funding and treating their transport networks in the best possible ways.

Learning a lesson or two will go a long way.
